

The Northeast Wisconsin ASHRAE Chapter Scholarship is intended to encourage college students to pursue studies that will qualify them for employment in the heating, refrigeration and air conditioning industry.

A \$1,500 scholarship for the 2019-2020 academic year will be awarded to undergraduate engineering, preferably but not limited to mechanical and architectural engineering, that meets the intended purpose stated above and will be selected each year by the Donor. The scholarship is open to graduating High School Seniors and current College students interested in pursuing/continuing a degree in the heating, refrigeration and air conditioning industry at the discretion of the Donor. The basic requirements set forth for this scholarship are:

- a) Candidate must be a full-time student enrolled in a college program leading to a professional degree in a field related to heating, refrigeration or air conditioning.
- b) Scholarship application of the donor shall be completed.
- c) Candidate must submit a recommendation from one (1) full time faculty member.
- d) Candidate shall submit no more than two (2) page double spaced essay on the topic of “Why I am interested in a career in the heating, refrigeration, or air conditioning industry.”
- e) Candidate must mail, postal or by electronically, proof of enrollment in a qualifying college program, the completed application, faculty recommendation and essay to the person and address below by May 1, 2019.

It is the intention of (ASHRAE)the Donor that this scholarship will be awarded to candidates who have graduated from a high school within the geographic boundaries of the Northeast Wisconsin Chapter of ASHRAE. Eligible candidates who don't meet this geographic criterion will still be considered.
