

Milwaukee School of Engineering 2026-2027 Citizenship Affidavit

Why do I have to fill this out?

Students are required to fill out the citizenship affidavit when, upon filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the Department of Education was unable to verify your citizenship status. This does not necessarily mean there is anything wrong with your citizenship status, it simply means that they could not confirm it for FAFSA filing purposes.

What happens if I don't fill this out?

MSOE will be unable to offer you need-based financial aid.

How do I complete this form?

View the table on the next page. Select one of the two options to confirm your citizenship with MSOE's Financial Aid Office.

1. Bring a valid, government issued photo ID and the relevant citizenship documents to fill out the affidavit in person to MSOE's Financial Aid Office.

OR

2. Visit a notary public and complete the form in person with them. Make sure to bring along a valid, government issued photo ID and relevant citizenship documents. Then, mail the <u>original affidavit</u> and <u>copies</u> of the documents presented to the notary to MSOE's Financial Aid Office at: 1025 N. Broadway, Milwaukee WI, 53202.

What is a notary public, and where can I find one?

A notary public is an individual issued an appointment by a governing financial institution to serve the public as an impartial witness, performing notarial acts as are allowed or required by law.

You may find a notary public often at UPS or FedEx stores, local libraries, local courthouses, or banks. You may also search for commissioned notaries public at: https://www.notaryrotary.com/

Do my personal documents need to be current?

Yes. You must present un-expired documents for them to be applicable to this document. Please note, that if your documents expire while you are at MSOE, you may be required to fill out this form again in a future academic year. We may ask you to renew or present other current documents if they expire within the academic year, you are presenting this document.

Can I just scan or fax this affidavit?

No. You must either present this affidavit in person to our office or mail the original copy to us.

Can I scan or fax documents?

If you are coming in person to MSOE's Financial Aid Office, then you must bring your original documents to be presented to the office. If you are mailing the original citizenship affidavit after having it notarized, then yes, you may scan copies of the documents to be submitted electronically.

How can I submit documents to MSOE?

- 1. In person. If you are completing this form with MSOE's Financial Aid Office, you may visit us between the hours of 8am 4:30pm, Monday through Friday at 1025 N. Broadway, Milwaukee, WI 53202
- 2. By mail if you are sending us the original citizenship affidavit notarized. Send to the Milwaukee School of Engineering, Attention Financial Aid Office, 1025 N. Broadway, Milwaukee, WI 53202. **Do not send us originals of your personal identifying documents.** Only send the original citizenship affidavit and copies of any documents presented to the notary public.
- 3. Electronically, only to send copies of any documents presented to the notary public. Please upload via the secure document upload portal at https://msoe.edu/Finaid
