



The Douglas Seaman Memorial Scholarship



Up to four students will receive the up to \$12,500 for the Douglas Seaman Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship will be for the upcoming academic year. This scholarship may be renewable at donor preference if the recipient continues to fulfill the agreed upon criteria listed below, and reapplies via MSOE's General Scholarship Application yearly.

Criteria

1. Be a full-time student with academic status as a freshman in the Fall of the award year, or be seeking renewal.
2. Be a permanent United States citizen seeking a professional baccalaureate degree in mechanical, industrial, electrical, civil, computer, software, biomedical, or biomolecular engineering from MSOE.
3. Students must have lived in one of the following counties for a period of at least four years prior to attending MSOE and have graduated from a local high school: Dodge, Fond Du Lac, Jefferson, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Sheboygan, Walworth, Washington, or Waukesha county.
4. Maintain a MSOE minimum grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
5. Applicants must have no prior criminal record and must be of good moral character.
