



MSOE University – School of Nursing - Application, Evaluation, and Acceptance Process (9.2021)

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing [BSN] - Accelerated Second Degree (BSN-ASD)
- Master of Science in Nursing [MSN], Direct Entry

Phase I: Application

Admission Criteria - Candidate has:

- Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree
- Cumulative GPA in prior degree of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale
 - If GPA 2.7 to < 3.0, transcripts will be reviewed case by case.

Candidate Submits:

- Transfer Student Application (no cost)
- Transcripts from prior colleges or schools

Phase II: Evaluation

Transcripts reviewed by:

- MSOE admission counselors
- SON Program Director(s)

Communication (email) to candidate from admission counselor:

- Link to informational video about programs
- Pre-requisite course work complete OR pre-requisite course work needed (list provided)
- Opportunity to meet with program director for questions.

Candidate returns:

- Intent to complete pre-requisite course work

Interview and writing assessment if GPA 2.7 to < 3.0

- interview for BSN-ASD
- Interview and writing for Direct Entry MSN

Communication to candidate:

- Accept into BSN-ASD Program (Yes/No)
- Accept into Direct Entry MSN Program (Yes/No)

Candidate completes:

- Pre-requisite course(s). Course work may be in process after accepted into program, however all courses need to be completed 3 weeks prior to start of program.

Phase III: Post Acceptance

Enrollment:

- MSOE admission counselor enrolls student in courses

Student completes clinical requirements prior to start of first quarter:

- Background checks, BLS, immunizations, health insurance, physical exam, tuberculosis screening, drug screen
- Documents submitted to contracted vendor

Student attends:

- Mandatory Orientation Day (prior to start of quarter)
- Order uniform
