Transferring to a New School

Your I-20 is a document that follows you from school to school. You will need it transferred to a different institution if you:

- 1. Decide that MSOE is not the right school for you
- 2. Want to complete a higher degree at a different institution after graduation
- 3. Want to complete a higher degree at a different institution after completing OPT or STEM OPT

How to Transfer Out Your I-20

From your new institution, you will need a(n):

- 1. Acceptance letter
- 2. Transfer form* (with the top half filled out by you)

Once you have these documents:

- 3. Send them to your DSO via email with a short explanation on when you plan to transfer If you did NOT complete your degree at MSOE:
 - 4. Fill out the <u>Withdrawal/Intent Not to Return Form</u>, obtain the necessary signatures and submit it to the Registrar's Office
 - 5. Return your laptop and pay the balance on your Student Account

*Your DSO will usually send this form directly to your new institution
