



International Student Financial Certificate

All international graduate students for the 2026–2027 academic year are required to certify funds for one year of study for tuition and fees, living expenses, and health insurance. The cost is reflected by which program you are enrolling into:

MBA/Master of Science in Engineering Management (MSEM): \$37,783

Master of Science in Engineering (MSE): \$46,375

Master of Science in Architectural Engineering (MSAE)/Master of Science in Civil Engineering (MSCVE): \$33,613

Master of Science in Machine Learning (MSML): \$45,604

Please remember you are financially responsible for your entire program of study.

Students holding F-1 visas are not authorized to work off campus during their first academic year. Employment, either part time during the academic year or full time during the summer, should not be considered a means of support while attending MSOE. Under no circumstances are international students permitted to work full time during the academic year.

Married students who plan to bring a spouse and/or children must certify a proportionately larger amount of finances on the basis of at least an additional \$4,500 per year (\$375 per month) for a spouse and \$2,400 (\$200 per month) for each child. F-2 visa holders (dependents of an F-1 visa holder) are not permitted to work under any circumstances.

A copy of this and other financial documentation may need to be provided to the United States Consulate/Embassy officials at the time of visa application.

PLEASE NOTE: Milwaukee School of Engineering does not issue Form DS-2019 for obtaining the J-1 (exchange visitor) visa. A Form I-20 (certificate for eligibility for F-1 visa) cannot be issued to you until you have been admitted to MSOE and have submitted original documents demonstrating proof of financial capability.
