

## Johnson Controls Scholarship



The MSOE Financial Aid Office is currently accepting applications for the 2018-2019 Johnson Controls Scholarship. Up to four qualified students will receive a \$30,638 half-tuition, technology, and room and board scholarship for the 2018-2019 school year. This scholarship may be renewable if the recipient fulfills the criteria below. Up to one scholarship will be available for students who studied at St. Joan Antida.

\*Standard room and board is a double room in Margaret Loock or Roy W. Johnson Halls and a standard meal plan. The housing portion of this scholarship is only available if student is living in MSOE housing.

## Criteria

- 1. Be a full-time student with academic standing of a freshman or sophomore in Fall 2018.
- 2. Be seeking a Computer Science or Computer, Electrical, Mechanical, or Software Engineering degree from MSOE.
- 3. Preference will be given to:
  - (a) Female and/or minority students
  - (b) Those students that demonstrate need
- 4. Must maintain a MSOE minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 grading system. Failure to meet the minimum GPA will result in a probation period and may result in the loss of the scholarship.



- 1. As advised, actively participate in programs to ensure academic success and full integration into the academic community.
- 2. Recipients may be eligible for an internship at Johnson Controls, if offered.
- 3. Schedule permitting, be willing to serve as a campus liaison for Johnson Controls, Inc. and attend selected MSOE professional and social functions as the Johnson Controls, Inc. Scholar.
- 4. If offered, must be willing to consider full-time employment with Johnson Controls, Inc. following graduation.
