To be considered a candidate for the Matthew Stachelski '11 Memorial Scholarship, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a qualified, full-time student seeking a professional, baccalaureate degree from MSOE.
- Preference will be given to students majoring in User Experience and Communication Design or with a minor in Technical Communications or UXCD.
- Maintain a MSOE minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 grading system.
- Be considered a non-traditional student in the sense of having some post-secondary work or junior college, university, or technical school experience.
