Wisconsin National Guard Tuition Grant (NGTG)

Who is eligible for the National Guard Tuition Grant?

All Wisconsin National Guard enlisted members and warrant officers in good standing who do not possess a bachelor's degree are eligible to receive the Wisconsin National Guard Tuition Grant. This benefit may be used toward eight (8) semesters of your college undergraduate education.

What are the benefits I will receive?

Reimbursement is currently up to 100% of the tuition and fees not covered by Post 9/11 G.I. Bill, other grants, scholarships, or remissions. The maximum reimbursement is the equivalent of the UW-Madison tuition rate.

How do I apply?

You will need to complete and submit the National Guard Tuition Grant Application no later than 60 days after the end of each term of enrollment. This application can be obtained from MSOE's Financial Aid Office or downloaded from the [Wisconsin National Guard Website](#). Finally, MSOE will need you to complete and submit their Veteran Benefit Payment Agreement.
