

FIRST THINGS FIRST

SET UP YOUR MYMSOE ACCOUNT

The Information Technology (IT) Department has created the account that you will use to log in to many of MSOE's systems, including your MSOE email account, *my.MSOE.edu* (where you register for classes and pay bills), and other campus systems. Follow the steps below to set up and access your account.

Find Your Username

To get started you will first need to look up your username, which is based on your first and last names. Go to *username.msoe.edu*. Type in your ID number (printed on your class schedule), your full first and last name and click the "Look Up" button.

Set Up Your Account Recovery Email Address

After you know your username, you will need to set up your recovery email address. This email address should be a non-msoe.edu email where we can send a one-time password to allow you to reset your password or unlock your account. To set up your recovery email, go to: pwdreq.msoe.edu and follow the instructions below:

- A. Enter your email address (which is your username with "@msoe.edu" at the end) in the login box.
- B. Enter your default password in the login box. For new accounts, your default password is **Msoe (only the "M" is capitalized)** followed by your **MSOE ID number (printed on your class schedule)** followed by **your birth date in MMDDYY format.** For example, if your ID number is 234234 and your birth date is 10/24/1990, then your default password is Msoe234234102490. Then click "Next."
- C. Enter your default password again and click "Next."
- D. Provide a recovery email address and click "Next."
- E. If your email address is successfully saved you will receive a message saying the process is complete. If not, it will tell you what additional information you need to provide.

Change Your Password

After you have set up your password security questions, you will need to change your password to something that you can remember. To change your password, *go to: pwd.msoe.edu* and follow the instructions below:

- A. Enter your email address (which is your username with "@msoe.edu" at the end) in the login box.
- B. You will be emailed a security code to your recovery email address. Provide this code and click "Next."
- C. Enter and confirm your new password. Your password must be at least 12 characters long. A link to the MSOE password guide is provided on the page with information on creating a secure password.
- D. If your new password meets the minimum requirements, you will receive a message that your password reset was successful and you are ready to log in.



Log in to my.MSOE.edu and check your email

Once you have found your username and set your new password, then you are ready to log on to *my.MSOE.edu* and your email account. *my.MSOE.edu* is where you'll go to access your student account information, check your grades, view bills, add or drop courses and more.

To log on to my.MSOE, go to: my.msoe.edu

To log on to your MSOE email, go to: outlook.com/msoe.edu

You will be prompted for your username and password.
