

STEM OPT Extension

Certain degrees at MSOE qualify for a <u>2-year STEM extension</u>. If you have earned a degree that will allow you to extend your OPT:

General Instructions

- You may apply for OPT up to 90 days before your intended start date
- You MUST apply for STEM OPT before your OPT has expired
- The <u>form I-983</u> must be completed by you and your employer in order to receive the I-20 with the STEM OPT recommendation from the DSO
 - This can take up to five business days to review
 - After form I-983 has been reviewed and accepted, you will be contacted via email. Following your response, your I-20 with the STEM OPT recommendation will be generated (which may take an additional up to 5 business days)
- Do not apply for STEM OPT without an updated I-20 with the STEM OPT recommendation
- You have 30 days to apply from the date that the I-20 with the STEM OPT recommendation is issued
- The application process generally takes approximately three months

Applying for STEM OPT

- 1. Complete the Form <u>I-983</u> training plan with your employer
- 2. Email the form I-983 to your DSO
- 3. Receive an email approving the form I-983, asking for specific information related to your employer
- 4. Respond to email, giving necessary employer information
- 5. Receive an updated Form I-20 with the STEM OPT recommendation
- 6. Decide if you want to Apply Online (Recommended) or mail your documents
- 7. Helpful Information
 - a. SEVIS School Code=CHI214F20242000
 - b. Your CIP code is also found on your I-20 in the "Program of Study" box under "Major"
 - c. Answer for number 27 is (c)(3)(C)
 - d. You will need your company's EIN and e-verification number*
- 8. Gather necessary documents*
 - a. Form <u>I-765</u> (Only if applying by mail)
 - b. Print out of I-94 arrival card
 - c. Copy of your passport biographical information page
 - d. 2 recent US passport-style pictures
 - e. Personal check made out to the *Department of Homeland Security*. See here for the most update information on the I-765 filing fee
 - i. If filing online, you may pay by credit card
 - f. Previous I-20s for OPT and CPT
 - g. Copy of previous EAD card(s)
 - h. Copy of diploma of STEM field degree.
 - i. Form G-1145 for E-notification of acceptance of application (Only if applying by mail)

*If applying online, some of these items will not be necessary

Waiting for and after Approval

- You can work on your prior EAD card for up to 180 days if you have applied before your post-completion OPT (EAD card) has expired
- You are allowed up to 90 days of unemployment once your STEM OPT application is approved (150 days of post-completion and STEM combined)
- You are responsible to keep up with reporting to your DSO, by sending an email with
 - 1. Your address and employer information, every 6 months
 - 2. Your **self-evaluation** on your progress regarding the goals on your I-983, found on pg. 5, at the *12-month* (top box) and *24 -month* (lower box) mark of employment, or when you finish working at a company
- Note: travel signatures are only valid for 6 months

^{*}if the company you work is not e-verified, suggest that they become e-verified. Here's how!
